





Curriculum



Coverage

 <p>Functional English</p>	<p><u>Non-fiction texts</u> Functional English will be incorporated throughout the curriculum. We will be looking at non-fiction texts linked to celebrations. We will be looking at parts of a book such as the contents & index and how to find information from books. Within our writing we will be focusing on sentence structure, punctuation, spelling and letter formation.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> We will have a spelling test every week.</p> <p><u>Reading</u> We will read our books every day.</p>
 <p>Functional Maths</p>	<p><u>Money, measurement and time</u> We will use real money when we visit the local cafe and in our class café. We will be making amounts with coins and learning how to give change. We will work on measures within cookery as well as other math's skills. We will be learning to tell the time and various aspects of measurement including weight, height, length and distance.</p>
 <p>Environment</p>	<p><u>Science</u> We will be learning all about light, the sources we get light from and why we need light. We will also be doing experiments to show why we need light. We will explore light through the festival of Diwali and Christmas. We will also use our senses to explore food, music & artefacts from celebrations and traditions. We will explore how materials change through cookery.</p> <p><u>Geography</u> We will look at celebrations from different countries, find and plot these on a map. We will explore celebrations from different countries and compare them to what we do.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Computing will be embedded into all subjects. We will use computers to create multimedia documents about our celebrations topic. We will cover online safety looking at how to be safe when using computers, iPads and any kind of technology. We will try to use a range of ICT within the community such as self-checkouts at supermarkets or the library.</p>
 <p>PHSE</p>	<p><u>Feelings, friends and friendship</u> Pupils will be learning about what makes a good friend and taking part in activities with their friends. We will be talking about emotions, feelings and healthy and unhealthy relationships. Anti-bullying links will be embedded throughout our PSHE lessons.</p>

 <p>ILS</p>	<p>Pupils will work on these skills throughout the week, trying to become as independent as possible. They will use the 'Croft' or cookery room to prepare their dinner every Wednesday. Each week pupils will take part in a class vote, to choose what dinner and pudding we will have the following week. They will follow simple recipes and use a wide range of kitchen equipment, thinking about how to keep safe whilst cooking.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>Pupils will try to visit places within the local community such as supermarkets to buy ingredients that we will use to cook our meal on a Wednesday, local places such as town, the library, local parks and cafes. We will think about our local community and our place within it. Please ensure pupils have a coat and suitable shoes every day although our community day is Tuesday.</p>
 <p>Creative & Expressive Arts</p>	<p><u>Art & DT</u> They will design and create objects using a range of materials. They will evaluate their work and think how they can improve it for next time. They will look at the work of famous artists.</p> <p><u>History</u> They will explore the history of celebrations and compare them to present day. We will look at artefacts and compare them to what we would use within our celebrations.</p> <p><u>RE (PPA subject taught by Neil Amos)</u> Students will look at religious beliefs within celebrations. They will explore special people and artefacts.</p> <p><u>Music (PPA subject taught by Rachel Pillar)</u> Students will explore a range of music linked to celebrations such as carnivals, Diwali, Christmas. They will explore pitch and tempo, comparing the music pieces and saying which ones they like and why.</p>
 <p>Sport & Exercise</p>	<p><u>Autumn 1 dance</u> Students will explore dances from different celebrations. They will use their body to make shapes, dance routines and travelling in different ways.</p> <p><u>Autumn 2 games</u> We will take part in a variety of team games, thinking about how to work together. We will learn new rules and use different equipment.</p>
 <p>Enrichment</p>	<p><u>Autumn 1 games</u> We will be sharing board games, jigsaws, remote control toys and games on the interactive whiteboard with middle 2 class.</p> <p><u>Autumn 2 café</u> Each class will explore the world of work and be responsible for running a café. Students will use real money to pay for items and work on social skills.</p>
