






**Summer 5 - Leisure**

 <p>Functional</p>  <p>English</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Comics</b></p> <p>We will be looking at a range of comics and discussing their features. We will learn about onomatopoeia and its effectiveness in comic books. Pupils will be planning and then creating their own comic strips. We will create our own characters and content to go in our comics and practise writing using onomatopoeia.</p> <p>Pupils will continue to have a spelling test each week - please practise the words as much as possible with your child at home.</p>
 <p>Functional</p>  <p>Maths</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Measurement - Money &amp; Time</b></p> <p>Pupils will be working on time and money skills. We will continue to learn how to make amounts of money using different coins and how to recognise the correct amount of change. We will continue to learn how to tell the time on an analogue and digital clock.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Number &amp; Problem Solving</b></p> <p>Pupils will be working on their problem solving skills by working out missing numbers in number patterns and finding out the answers to word problems. We will also be doing some tally work and creating bar graphs from our results.</p>
 <p>Environment</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Habitats &amp; living things</b></p> <p>We will learn about different habitats and examine mini beasts in the school environment. We will learn about living things and life cycles.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Keeping healthy</b></p> <p>We will learn about how we can keep our bodies' healthy including diet and exercise.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Geography</b></p> <p>We will be exploring habitats around the world and the animals/plants that live there.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Programming</b></p> <p>Pupils will be learning about programming and why computers need precise instructions. We will learn how to program bee bots and how to debug them.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Online safety lesson</b></p> <p>We will continue to learn how to keep ourselves safe online.</p>

 <p>PHSE</p>	<p><b>Keeping safe</b></p> <p>We will cover a range of topics such as road safety, water safety, safe/unsafe places, sun safety and safe/unsafe people. We will work on the knowledge that students already have and build upon this.</p>
 <p>Independent Living Skills</p>	<p>Pupils will be cooking different meals each week. We will be practising life skills through cooking, cleaning, using different equipment, setting the table and hygiene. Each week pupils will vote for a meal to make the following week.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>Pupils will continue to visit places within the local community. We will use a range of supermarkets to buy snack and ingredients that we will use to cook our meal on a Wednesday. We will visit local places such as supermarkets, local parks and cafes.</p> <p><b>Please ensure pupils have a coat and suitable shoes every day.</b></p>
 <p>Creative &amp; Expressive Arts</p>	<p><b>Art &amp; DT</b></p> <p>We will be working through the process of designing, making and evaluating to create items such as kites and jewellery.</p> <p><b>RE - Taught by PPA cover Neil Amos</b>  <b>Music - Taught by PPA cover Rachel Pillar</b></p>
 <p>PE</p>	<p><b>Athletics</b></p> <p>We will be practising a range of skills including running, jumping and throwing. We will doing activities such as relay races, hurdles and shot put to practise these skills.</p>
 <p>Enrichment</p>	<p><b>Team games</b></p> <p>Middle 3 will join with Middle 2 to do a range of games including parachute games, team building games and a scavenger hunt.</p>
