


Coverage



English

Fiction - Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

Reading and following chapters within the book, watching scenes from the film, adjectives and describing words, describing settings within the story and different characters.



Maths

Number

Rote counting in multiples of 5s, 10s, 20s. Times tables, ordering numbers and place value.

Measure - Money

Recognizing different coins and notes and making different amounts to buy ingredients for self-prep.



Environment

Food chains and digestive system

Finding out about the different food chains throughout the animal kingdom. Looking at the different types of animals (omnivores, herbivores and carnivores).

Learning about how we eat, the digestive system and performing different experiments to help us understand these processes.




Computing

Data handling

We are looking at data handling this term. We will relate it to the topic of food by finding out what are the favourite foods within class for example fruit, flavour of crisps and vegetables!

Pupils will be using MS word and MS excel to create tables.

We will also be researching recipes and designing menus.



PHSE

Taught by Alison Rodgers

We are focusing on how to be healthy this term. Health, diet and exercise. We will be learning about colour coding on food packets; what a healthy diet is; portion sizes and forms of exercise.

We will also be designing healthy meals - breakfast, lunch and tea!



Independent Living Skills

Self-Prep

Pupils will be cooking different meals each week. We will be practising life skills through cooking, cleaning, using different equipment, setting the table and hygiene. Each week pupils will vote for a meal to make.



Community

Pupils will be visiting places within the local community. We will use a range of supermarkets to buy snack and ingredients that we will use to cook our meal on a Wednesday. We will visit local places such as town, the library and local parks and cafes.



Creative & Expressive Arts

Art & DT - Chocolate

Using the work of Italian artist Arcimbaldo to recreate our own portraits using fruits and vegetables. Researching currently available chocolate bars and their ingredients, researching wrappers, designing their own chocolate bar, ingredients and wrapper, making their own chocolate bar and wrapper and evaluating their chocolate bar.

RE

Throughout the term we will be looking at festivals and celebrations which involve food! We will learn about the Jewish festival Sukkot and how it is celebrated. The tradition of cheese rolling and how people celebrate weddings and birthdays.

Music - Taught by Rachel Pillar

This term we will be developing our rhythm skills with the theme of food. This will involve practicing our rhythm skills, making our own rhythms and making rhythmic raps.

Ball skills and swimming

We will be working on our throwing and catching skills linked with both netball and basketball.
We will also be swimming on Fridays.
