







Secondary Curriculum Coverage

 <p>English</p>	<p>English topic this term is 'Wartime' We will be practising our reading, writing and speaking and listening skills through activities such as report writing, researching, role playing etc. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction related to Wartime.</p>	
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Shape and time Recapping on the skills we have learnt this year and continuing to develop our knowledge around shape and time.</p>	<p>Money Measurement Position & Direction Recapping on the skills we have learnt this year and continuing to develop our knowledge around money, measurement and position & direction.</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p>Healthy eating We will be learning about the 5 food groups and the foods we need to eat to have a healthy, balanced diet.</p> <p>Health related occupations We will be learning about people who help us to make sure we stay healthy, for example a Doctor or Dentist.</p>	<p>Rules We will be learning about the importance of rules and when we need to follow rules. We will be looking at school rules, general rules when out in public and the law.</p>
 <p>Citizenship</p>	<p>Developing our school grounds We will be looking around school and discussing how we can develop the school grounds. We will then spend time outside throughout the term developing our school grounds</p>	

 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Games/remote control toys We will be exploring various games and remote control toys to see how we can programme them and play with them.</p> <p>Online safety We will be learning about how to stay safe online and the dangers we must avoid in order to keep ourselves safe so we can enjoy playing and learning on the internet.</p>	
 <p>Science</p>	<p>Plants and photosynthesis We will be learning about the parts of plants, what plants need to survive, where we can find plants and how photosynthesis happens.</p>	<p>Energy resources We will be learning about different energy sources and how energy is created. We will also learn about renewable and non-renewable energy.</p>
 <p>PE</p>	<p>Thai Chi A company will be coming into school every week to teach the pupils Thai Chi.</p>	<p>Follow it, Find it We will be focussing on orienteering and playing games such as 'capture the flag'.</p>
 <p>RE Taught by Ali Rodgers</p>	<p>Does having a religion help people feel peaceful? We will be discussing whether being part of a religion helps people feel peaceful. We will focus on what conflict and peace means and how this relates to our world today. We will be looking into different religions and what their beliefs are about conflict and peace. We will be discussing what a peacemaker is, their role and what effect they can have within conflict, We will look at Corymeela in Northern Ireland and what they have down in relation to peace making.</p>	<p>What can the Baha'i faith teach us? We are going to be learning about the Baha'i faith. We will be learning about the history of the faith and its key leaders. The main belief within the faith is 'unity' so we will focus on this theme and discuss what this means to us and also the world. We will also be looking at symbols within the faith and also their temples.</p>
 <p>Art Taught by Ali Rodgers</p>	<p>Personal Places, Public Space We are going to be looking at art work around Chesterfield and researching what it is, who the artist is and what it represents. We will be taking photographs of the different pieces of local art work and also drawing them in our sketch books. We will then discuss how we feel about the different pieces; which we like or don't like and why? We will be focusing on making our own piece of public art. We will be designing, making and evaluating our own murals. The focus of these will be on the forest schools work we are doing in school. The finished murals will then be displayed around the school as public pieces of art work.</p>	
 <p>Technology</p>	<p>Mini enterprise - resistant materials We will be looking at various materials and discussing their uses. We will be designing, making and evaluating our own mouse mat.</p>	<p>Tee shirt challenge We will be exploring a range of clothing with familiar logos and identify how they have been produced. We will then design, make and evaluate our own item of clothing.</p>
 <p>Music</p>	<p>Rhythm/ Jamaican Music We will be experiencing and creating our own Jamaican music using instruments such as steel drums.</p>	<p>Sea Shanties We will be experiencing and creating our own music from the sea and beyond using various types of instruments.</p>

 Geography	 History	<p>The restless earth Rivers, floods, disasters</p> <p>We will be learning about our earth and the disasters that could happen within the world including floods and tsunamis. We will look at a world map to see where disasters have happened.</p>	<p>WW1/ WW2 Leadership of Winston Churchill</p> <p>We will be learning about the two world wars and looking at how they affected people's lives. We will also learn about whom Winston Churchill was and his importance throughout WW2.</p>
