Curriculum



Coverage

 <p>Functional English</p>	<p><u>Fiction and Non-fiction texts</u></p> <p>Functional English will be incorporated throughout the curriculum. We will be engaging with books through sensory resources. We will look out for social signs around school and when out in the community and work on recognising them. We will use symbols and objects of reference to help with our understanding. We will be doing a lot of work on communication with each other and with the wider school community. We will be using the story of Around the World in 80 Days as the basis of our work this term.</p>
 <p>Functional Maths</p>	<p><u>Money, measures and time</u></p> <p>We will use real money in our and when out in the community in shops and cafés. We will work on measures within cookery as well as other math's skills. We will use our sensory timetable & look at key times of the day. We will be working on making groups of objects and adding and take away objects from them.</p>
 <p>Environment</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>We will explore geology and the Earth with particular interest in the countries visited in our journey Around the World in 80 Days.</p> <p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will look at a different country each week as we study Around the World in 80 Days, these will include Chesterfield/Britain, Switzerland, Mexico, Tanzania, France, Egypt and USA.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Computing will be embedded into all subjects. We will use computers and search engines to find images of each of the countries we are considering and print out images for a scrap book . We will try to use a range of ICT within the community such as self-checkouts at supermarkets or the library as well as computers, i-Pads, interactive whiteboards and the sensory room in school.</p>
 <p>PHSE</p>	<p>This term we will be considering Growing and Changing as people. You will have received a letter explaining what will be covered in these sessions.</p>

 <p>ILS</p>	<p>We will work on these skills throughout the week, trying to become as independent as possible. We will use the 'Croft' or cookery room to prepare food once a week which relates to the theme of The Earth with recipes from around the world. We will follow simple recipes and use a wide range of kitchen equipment, thinking about how to keep safe whilst cooking.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>We will try to visit places within the local community such as supermarkets to buy ingredients that we will use to cook in the Croft, local places such as town, the library, local parks and cafes. We will think about our local community and our place within it. We will also be visiting a school café and mixing with students from other classes to access the school community. Please ensure pupils have a coat and suitable shoes every day although our community day is Tuesday.</p>
 <p>Creative & Expressive Arts</p>	<p><u>Art & DT</u> We will design and create 3D models and have the opportunity to explore and experience a wide range of materials used to make them. We will also have the opportunity to choose from a range what we want to use and express our own opinions of the finished object.</p> <p><u>RE</u> We will look at special religious times around the world from a range of different religions.</p> <p><u>History</u> We will explore the history of the earth including dinosaurs and how the earth was formed.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will explore a range of cultural music from around the world and use instruments and our voices to develop this.</p>
 <p>Sport & Exercise</p>	<p><u>Spring 3 Gymnastics</u> We will explore gymnastics and will be learning how we can move our bodies.</p> <p><u>Spring 4 Striking and Fielding</u> We will take part in a variety of striking and fielding games and experience taking part as a member of a team.</p>
 <p>Enrichment</p>	<p><u>Spring 3 and 4</u> Preparation for the Middle School production</p>
