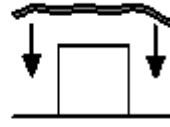












Curriculum



Coverage

Topic - Leisure

 <p>Functional English</p>	<p>Students use functional English skills throughout the week, using symbols and objects of reference on the timetable and in practical activities such as when cooking.</p> <p>Our sensory story will be about camping and we will be investigating a range of camping equipment and exploring the outdoors.</p> <p>We will continue with our environmental phonics activities to support our understanding of the world around us.</p>
 <p>Functional Maths</p>	<p>Maths this term will continue to be taught through a range of functional and practical activities.</p> <p>We will continue to work on counting and will do this through scoring in a variety of different games and sports. We will be thinking about time by relating it to our timetable and starting and stopping activities.</p>
 <p>Environment</p>	<p>Science - habitats & plants</p> <p>We will explore different habitats around school and examine mini beasts. Our main focus will be on plants and growing them from seeds. We will also pick and cook some vegetables.</p> <p>Geography</p> <p>We will be exploring habitats, around the world and the animals that live there. We will follow instructions and maps to move around the school grounds.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>In Computing we will be using programmable and electronic toys. We will go out into the quad and use beebots and remote control cars.</p> <p>We will all have access to the whiteboard and i-pads and use them for cause and effect games.</p> <p>Some students will also be using the eye-gaze for making choices.</p>
 <p>PHSE</p>	<p>Keeping safe</p> <p>We will cover a range of topics such as how to stay safe in the environment and who can help us when we are out and about.</p> <p>Hobbies</p> <p>We will look at what hobbies are and what students like to do. We will compare our hobbies to our friends.</p>

 <p>ILS</p>	<p>Students will explore and experience a range of foods that would be eaten on a picnic camping trip leading up to having a picnic together in the Forest School area.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>Students will continue to take a full part in the school community and particularly mixing with other students from Middle 1 at the café they run.</p>
 <p>Creative & Expressive Arts</p>	<p><u>Art & DT</u> We will be taking photographs this term using both cameras and i-pads and will then be making frames with natural materials to put them in.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will explore music that students enjoy and look at a range of types. We will talk about the difference between them.</p>
 <p>Sport & Exercise</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Summer 1 athletics</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Summer 2 outdoor and adventurous activities</u></p>
 <p>Enrichment</p>	<p><u>Summer 1 team games</u> Students will do things as a team such as games, baking, talking or music.</p> <p><u>Summer 2 café</u> Each class will explore the world of work and be responsible for running a café. Students will use real money to pay for items and work on social skills.</p>
