

















Secondary Curriculum Coverage

In the summer term, Middle 4 class will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>English</p>	<p>The topic for summer term 5 and 6 is "wartime".</p> <p>Reading- We will be reading a fiction sensory story about WW2 'The lion and the unicorn' during summer term 5 and 6.</p> <p>Mark making- We will be using materials from and linked to the story to mark make with. We will also be focusing on fine motor skills.</p> <p>Communication -We will be making choices using objects and symbols linked to the story.</p>	
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>In summer term 5 we will be focusing on number, shape and time.</p> <p>Number rhyme - 5 speckled frogs.</p> <p>We will be making jam tarts-counting through baking.</p>	<p>In summer term 6 we will be focusing on number, money, measurement and position.</p> <p>Number rhyme - 5 currant buns.</p> <p>We will be making sweet and savoury pastry puffs -counting through baking.</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p>In summer term 5 our topics are 'Healthy eating and Health related occupations'. We will be exploring healthy foods.</p> <p>We hope to go to the supermarket to buy healthy food. We will also be learning about the job of our school nurse.</p>	<p>In summer term 6 our topic is Rules. We will be learning about our school rules and making class rules.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>During summer terms 5 and 6 we will be focusing on the topic 'Games/ Remote control toys'. We will be playing jigsaw maker games on the interactive whiteboard. We will be using switches to control toys and objects. We will also be exploring remote control toys, roamers and bee bots.</p> <p>Pupils will also spend time, on Choose It Maker, using the eye gaze or SEN switcher program on the Interactive Whiteboard and will visit the sensory room each week, controlling equipment in there.</p>	
 <p>Science</p>	<p>(Science is taught in our Knowledge and understanding of the world lesson) The topic for summer term 5 is 'Plants'. We will be going on sensory walks around the school ground, collecting leaves and planting</p>	<p>(Science is taught in our Knowledge and understanding of the world lesson) The topic for summer term 6 is 'Exploring with senses same and different'.</p>

	seeds in the raised beds. We will also be exploring the different parts of a plant.	
 <p>Physio and PE</p>	<p>During summer term 5 Pupils will follow their individual physio plans. Pupils will also be exploring movement to different music and playing games stopping when the music stops.</p>	<p>During summer term 6 Pupils will follow their individual physio plans. Topic - follow it and find it, pupils will be exploring the school grounds, following trails.</p>
 <p>Citizenship</p>	<p>This term our topic is 'Developing our school grounds', we will be finding areas around school to tidy or develop i.e. by planting seeds etc.</p>	
 <p>RE</p>	<p>Our RE day will be on Friday 12th May 2017. Our topic is 'Does having a religion help people feel peaceful?'. We hope to visit St Thomas' church for the day.</p>	<p>The topic we will be learning about in summer term 6 is 'What can the Baha'i faith teach us?'</p>
 <p>Art</p>	<p>The topics we are working on during summer term 5 are 'Collaborative art and Texture - thickened' We will be working together to make collaborative artwork, using thickened materials. We will be looking at and trying to create art work in the style of of artist John Levee 'Drawing' 1955.</p>	<p>The topics we are working on during summer term 6 are 'Exhibitions and shape - rounded shapes'. We will be making rounded shaped art work and putting them into a class exhibition.</p>

 <p>DT</p>	<p>The topic we are working on during summer term 5 is 'mini enterprise' pupils will be working in 2 teams. They will be researching, designing, making and then evaluating making buns or biscuits. Our DT day will be on Tuesday 25th April 2017.</p>	<p>The topic we are working on during summer term 6 is 'Tee shirt challenge'.</p>
 <p>Music</p>	<p>The topic for summer term 5 is rhythm/ Jamaican music. We will be listening to and playing instruments along to reggae and calypso music.</p>	<p>The topic for summer term 6 is Sea Shanties.</p>
 <p>History</p>	<p>No History during summer term 5</p>	<p>The topic for summer term 6 is 'WW1 /WW2 and the Leadership of Winston Churchill. We will be exploring what it would have been like during the war. We will be having a History day.</p>
 <p>Geography</p>	<p>The topic for summer term 5 is 'The restless earth and rivers, floods and disasters '. We will be learning about how our earth changes through earthquakes, volcanos and floods. We will be making our own volcano. We will also be making a toy town and explore what happens when it is flooded. Our geography day will be on Monday 22nd May 2017.</p>	<p>No Geography during summer term 6.</p>
 <p>R-time</p>	<p>The R-time theme during summer term 5 is listening. R-time will be taught during music this term, focusing on listening and moving to Jamaican music and choosing instruments from choices.</p>	<p>The R-time theme during summer term 6 is co-operating.</p>

 <p>Sensory Exploration</p>	<p>Pupils have the chance to be involved in Sherborne, Tac Pac and Massage sessions.</p>	
 <p>Enrichment</p>	<p>For the summer term our enrichment topic is our community. We will be exploring our school and local community.</p>
