





Curriculum



Coverage

 <p>Functional English</p>	<p><u>Non-fiction texts</u> Functional English will be incorporated throughout the curriculum. We will be looking at parts of a book such as the contents & index and how to find information from books. We will look out for social signs in and around school and work on recognising them. We will be writing a weekly diary extract about our weekend news, focusing on sentence structure, spelling and letter formation.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> Pupils will follow the letters and sounds or better words scheme of work.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> We will have a spelling test every fortnight.</p>
 <p>Functional Maths</p>	<p><u>Money, measures and time</u> We will use real money when we visit the local cafe and in our class café. We will be looking at, recognizing and making amounts with coins. We will work on measures within cookery as well as other math's skills. We will learn our new timetable, look at key times of the day, work on time recognition and play time bingo. We will mark key events and festivals on our own calendar.</p>
 <p>Environment</p>	<p><u>Science</u> We will explore light through the festival of Diwali and Christmas. We will explore different light sources. We will also use our senses to explore food, music & artefacts from celebrations and traditions. We will explore how materials change through cookery.</p> <p><u>Geography</u> We will look at celebrations from different countries, find and plot these on a map. We will explore celebrations from different countries and compare them to what we do.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Computing will be embedded into all subjects. We will use computers to design items. Pupils will also be creating a multimedia documents about our celebrations topic. We will cover online safety looking at how to be safe when using computers, iPads and any kind of technology. We will try to use a range of ICT within the community such as self-checkouts at supermarkets or the library.</p>
 <p>PHSE</p>	<p><u>Feelings, friends and friendship</u> Pupils will be learning about what makes a good friend and taking part in activities with their friends. We will be talking about emotions, feelings, healthy and unhealthy relationships. We will also have an anti-bullying lesson.</p>



ILS

Pupils will work on these skills throughout the week, trying to become as independent as possible. They will use the 'Croft' or cookery room to prepare their dinner every Wednesday. This term, each meal will link to the celebration we are learning about that week. Each week pupils will take part in a class vote, to choose what pudding we will have the following week. They will follow simple recipes and use a wide range of kitchen equipment, thinking about how to keep safe whilst cooking.



Community

Pupils will try to visit places within the local community such as supermarkets to buy ingredients that we will use to cook our meal on a Wednesday, local places such as town, the library, local parks and cafes. We will think about our local community and our place within it.

Please ensure pupils have a coat and suitable shoes every day although our community day is Tuesday.



Creative & Expressive Arts

Art & DT

They will design and create objects using a range of materials. They will evaluate their work and think how they can improve it for next time. They will look at the work of famous artists.

History

They will explore the history or celebrations and compare them to present day. We will look at artefacts and compare them to what we would use within our celebrations.

RE (PPA subject taught by Rachel Pillar)

Students will look at religious beliefs within celebrations. They will explore special people and artefacts.

Music (PPA subject taught by Rachel Pillar)

Students will explore a range of music linked to celebrations such as carnivals, Diwali, Christmas. They will explore pitch and tempo, comparing the music pieces and saying which ones they like and why.



Sport & Exercise

Autumn 1 dance

Students will explore dances from different celebrations. They will use their body to make shapes and work on travelling in different ways.

Autumn 2 games

We will take part in a variety of team games, thinking about how to work together. We will learn new rules and use different equipment.



Enrichment

Autumn 1 games

We will be sharing board games, jigsaws, the beet bots, remote control toys and games on the interactive whiteboard with middle 4 class.

Autumn 2 café

Each class will explore the world of work and be responsible for running a café. Students will use real money to pay for items and work on social skills.
