





Coverage

Our topic for Autumn 1 is Treasure.

Blue Class will be working on the following subjects:

 <p>English</p>	<p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>We will be reading and reacting to the sensory story 'My granny is a pirate', to encourage listening and roleplay skills. Pupils will explore the sensory props, look at and label pictures from the story and participate in matching activities.</p> <p><b>Writing</b></p> <p>Pupils will be using different resources and mediums to encourage pre writing skills, working on their fine motor skills through activities such as dough disco, funky fingers, mark making and over writing.</p> <p><b>Communication and language</b></p> <p>Pupils will be taking part in listening games related to our topic. They will be using symbols and individual communication aids to encourage them to communicate with others.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p><b>Number</b></p> <p>Pupils will be doing various activities to develop their number skills such as rhymes, counting, matching &amp; sorting and grouping.</p> <p><b>Measurement</b></p> <p>Pupils will be doing various activities to learn about money and time such as rhymes, matching, sorting and baking.</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p><b>Caring</b></p> <p>We will be learning about looking after ourselves and others, looking at and practising daily routines, looking at job roles of people that help us. We will also be learning about caring for animals and pets and experience caring for pets through role play</p> <p><b>My family</b></p> <p>We will be learning about our families through activities such as creating family trees, matching labels to pictures and role play.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p><b>Toys and games (Computer science)</b></p> <p>Pupils will be exploring a range of toys and games including remote control toys and iPads to experience cause and effect.</p>

 <p>Science</p>	<p><b>Materials</b> We will be exploring different materials and experimenting to find out how we can change them.</p> <p><b>Forces</b> We will be exploring various materials and objects to see if they float or sink.</p>
 <p>PE</p>	<p><b>Fundamental movement skills</b> <b>Running, jumping, throwing and catching</b> Pupils will practise running, jumping, throwing and catching skills through a range of different practical activities.</p> <p><b>Swimming</b> Pupils to gain confidence in the water and achieve swimming certificates.</p>
 <p>RE</p>	<p><b>How and why should we care for our world?</b> Taught by Chloe Taylor (PPA cover)</p>
 <p>Art</p>	<p><b>Paint and colour</b> Pupils will be learning to make marks in paint using different tools. We will learn about primary colours and do some colour mixing!</p>
 <p>Technology</p>	<p><b>Making a treasure box</b> Pupils will design and make their own treasure box to keep their special things in. They will explore different materials and fabrics to create their treasure box.</p>
 <p>Music</p>	<p><b>Timbre - Body / vocal sounds</b> Taught by Rachel Pillar (PPA cover)</p>
 <p>History</p>	<p><b>No History this term</b></p>
 <p>Geography</p>	<p><b>My home on an island</b> Pupils will be learning about different countries and how climates are different - exploring hot and cold through sensory experiences.</p>
