













Curriculum

|  <p>English</p> | <p>Reading - Pupils will be reading the following books 'Driving my Tractor' and 'Spot goes to the Farm'. Pupils will work on matching symbols, photographs and words.</p> <p>Writing - Making initial mark making and repetitive writing patterns. Cutting skills (fine motor). Some pupils will continues on independently writing their names.</p> <p>Communication and Language - initial letter sounds and using different ways to communicate.</p> |
|  <p>Maths</p> | <p>Number - Recognition of numbers, ordering numbers, counting objects adding/subtracting one or two to an amount and ordinal numbers.</p> <p>Measure- Capacity, Prepositions and Weight</p> <p>Shape- Identifying, matching and giving facts about 2d and 3d shapes.</p> |
|  <p>PSHE</p> | <p>Ourselves - Pupils will be working on their self-help skills like getting dressed/undressed and washing themselves after swimming.</p> <p>Playing and Learning Together - Pupils will be working with their friends to play and complete activities.</p> <p>Rules - Pupils will be looking at game rules and school rules.</p> |
|  <p>Computing</p> | <p>Listening and Responding to Sound: Pupils will be exploring and identifying different sounds in different environments and will work on recording sound.</p> |
