












Curriculum



Coverage

In the Summer Term, Orange Class will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>English</p>	<p>Beach</p> <p>Pupils will be learning how to story write. They will be learning to use plans and how to brainstorm ideas individually and as a group. Pupils will begin to learn to find any mistakes within their work and use correct punctuation and letter formation.</p>	<p>Lighthouse keepers lunch</p> <p>Pupils will extend their knowledge in planning and story writing, expanding their ideas and learning to include a beginning, middle and end. Pupils will also be focusing on correct letter formation and punctuation.</p> <p>Pupils will begin to learn about comprehension of texts they will read and answer questions relating to the text.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Number</p> <p>Pupils will be learning multiplication sums. Finding correct sum symbols to place in pre written sums, and learning numbers to 100.</p> <p>Time</p> <p>Pupils will be learning the concept of time and daily routines.</p> <p>Pupils will also be learning half past and o'clock</p> <p>Money</p> <p>Pupils will work on using different coins and learn how to pay for items in a mock shop situation. Pupils will expand this by visiting shops in the local community and practising their skills in real life situations.</p>	<p>Shape</p> <p>Pupils will be learning that shapes are the same relative of their size and will be learning to recognise the many 2D and 3D shapes.</p> <p>Position & direction</p> <p>Pupils will be learning about many different positions and directions such as left, right, forward and backwards.</p> <p>Measurement</p> <p>Pupils will be comparing lengths and estimating the measurement of different items.</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p>Pupils will be learning about beach safety in topic and in main PSHE pupils will be learning how people are the same, different and unique</p>	<p>Pupils will learn about the awareness of their ability.</p> <p>Pupils will learn about what is healthy to eat and have the opportunity to take part in having a picnic.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Pupils will be learning about controlling the environment by using electronic equipment and ICT.  <p>Science</p>	<p>Rocks</p> <p>Pupils will investigate rocks. Where they come from what they look like and composition. Pupils will look at torches and toys as well as kitchen equipment and they work using electricity.</p>
