







Coverage

In the Summer Term, Silver Class will be working on the following topics and themes.

Water

 <p>Literacy</p>	<p>Mark making - Using different mediums to encourage pre writing skills.</p> <p>Communication - Using speech and language techniques which include intensive interaction, eye pointing and augmentative & alternative communication aids to encourage pupils to communicate with others.</p> <p>Stories - Using topic related sensory stories, non-fiction and poetry to encourage listening and role play skills.</p>
 <p>Numeracy</p>	<p>Cookery - this multi- sensory activity covers every area of mathematics:</p> <p>Counting and using numbers</p> <p>Calculating: Experiencing mathematical vocabulary</p> <p>Position and direction: We will be experiencing different sensory activities to help us reinforce our understanding of up and down etc.</p> <p>Using and applying - Making choices</p>
 <p>PSHE</p>	<p>Making personal choices and Knowing how I am changing - developing awareness of our peers, interacting with others for extended periods and making choices.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Movement, the Senses & Exploration! - working on our understanding of cause and effect through different digital platforms such as eye-gaze, switches, iPad's and the sensory room</p>

	<p>Covers Science and humanities -</p> <p>'Grouping and changing materials/Water' - children will be doing different activities and experiments that focus on water and changing materials.</p>
 <p>Swimming & Physio</p>	<p>Following personalised swimming, MOVE and physiotherapy programmes.</p>
 <p>Sherbourne</p>	<p>An approach to teaching and working with movement that is accessible, especially for people with minimal movement.</p>
 <p>Art</p>	<p><i>Sensory art</i> - based around our topic - create a water scene using different textures.</p>
 <p>Music</p>	<p>Duration - We will be focusing on long and short sounds and playing different sensory games and singing different songs to reinforce our understanding of long and short sounds</p>
 <p>R.E</p>	<p>Our R.E is delivered over a full day each half term.</p> <p>The topics we will be looking at this half term are: Why do we wear different clothes on different occasions? What happens at a wedding?</p>
