






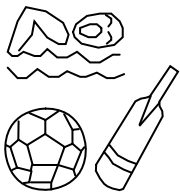






Curriculum
