


Curriculum



Coverage

In the Spring Term 3, Upper 1 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>Community</p>	<p>This year we will be finding out about and using community facilities. This term we will be asking questions about the shopping facilities in Chesterfield. Students will be given the opportunity to shop in a number of different places, for example; shopping in Morrisons for self-prepared meals. They will also visit a variety of parks, staff will encourage the students to build relationships with their peers.</p>
 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>This term we will be working on an enterprise project which will lead up to the Easter Fayre. We will be working together to find ways to make money. One of our ideas for the fayre is to have a tombola, so if you have any unwanted Christmas gifts, chocolates, bottles of wine etc we'd really appreciate them for our stall!</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>This year we will be looking at taking part in daily routine activities. This term we will identify activities that we carry out to prepare for shopping trips in Chesterfield town centre. We will also learn about staying safe when out and about.</p>
 <p>Independent</p>  <p>Living</p>  <p>Skills</p>	<p>This year we will be looking at planning and preparing a simple meal. This term the students will take it in turns to be in charge. Each week one student will choose what we are going to eat and will be 'head chef' in the kitchen; They will.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Design the menu.</li> <li>• Write the shopping list.</li> <li>• Work with other students to prepare and serve the food.</li> </ul> <p>We will also be practicing household chores (such as</p>

	hoovering, sweeping, dusting and washing pots) and developing independence around showering.
 <p>Options</p>	In Opportunities this term we will be running a café. This will provide the students will valuable work experience and enable them to practice their functional English and maths skills.
 <p>sport</p>	<p>The topic for this term is dance, aerobics and keep fit. On Mondays we will learn about Capoeira, the Brazilian sport, students will learn key moves and how to sequence them to music. On a Thursday afternoon we will have a keep fit class which will include copying actions, dancing and relaxation.</p> <p>We will continue our Thursday afternoon swimming sessions.</p>
 <p>English</p>	This term our topic is Animals, and we are focusing on 'writing to explain'. We will be creating a book with instructions on how to look after 'wild and wonderful pets'.
 <p>Maths</p>	<p><b>Money:</b> we will be focusing on naming the coins and combining coins to make simple totals. We will be looking at how to spend and make money during our Vocational sessions and during community sessions.</p> <p><b>Measurement:</b> we will be weighing, measuring and counting out ingredients during cooking sessions in The Croft.</p> <p><b>Number:</b> we will be having a 'maths fit' session each week. During these sessions we will do a variety of fitness activities with a focus on counting and using ordinal numbers.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	This term we are studying the topic 'Biology: Evolution and Inheritance'. We will look at fossils, dinosaurs and adaptations of animals
