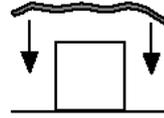



Curriculum



Coverage

In the Spring Term 3, Upper 1 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>Community</p>	<p>In community this term we will be thinking about which communities we belong to and why they are important to us. We will also work on our reading skills when shopping and managing money when visiting a café.</p>
 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>This half term Vocational will be replaced with Forest Schools. We will be visiting the Forest Schools site every Wednesday afternoon and taking part in sessions planned by the Forest School teacher.</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>In PSD this year we will be following the OCR unit 'Engaging in new creative activities'. This term the students will be learning circus skills such as juggling, balancing, throwing at targets and clown acts. We hope to perform a circus show to school staff at the end of the term.</p>
 <p>Independent</p>  <p>Living</p>  <p>Skills</p>	<p>In ILS this year we are doing the OCR unit; 'Participating in carrying out household tasks'. This half term students will be focusing on choosing the correct cleaning materials to use for a job and completing a series of tasks (eg washing, drying, folding and putting away the washing). Students will also continue to make their own snacks, drink and dinner and will be baking their own puddings. All students will also be using the shower. Students will also have the opportunity to spend time doing jobs in the garden and relaxing in the living room.</p>

 <p>Options</p>	<p>The options for this term are: Hair and Beauty; Garden Maintenance and Art and Design. I have highlighted the option that your child chose.</p>
 <p>sport</p>	<p>In exercise this half term our topic is 'Following the Rules of Game Play'. We will be playing a range of games as a class that focus on developing team work, physical stamina and turn taking.</p>
 <p>English</p>	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on writing skills. Students will be using and developing their writing skills by creating their own job lists for when they in the Croft. In English lessons we will be reading and acting out the story of Nanny McPhee and students will write a dairy to record what they do.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths this half term students will be using and developing their number skills in the Croft while baking, setting the tables, preparing dinner and sorting crockery/cutlery. As part of our community work students will be visiting a local café where they will be using money and reading the menu. They will also be developing their understanding and use of coins and notes in the classroom.</p>
