


Upper Senior




Curriculum



Coverage

In the Summer Term 6, Upper 1 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>Community</p>	<p>This year we will be finding out about and using community facilities. This term we will be shopping in Morrison's each week, going out to various cafes/pubs for a drink and riding the bikes in Queens Park. Students will work on exhibiting appropriate behaviour and greeting members of the public appropriately.</p>
 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>This half term we will be having Forest School lessons instead of Vocational.</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>This term we will be learning about Sex and Relationships.</p>
 <p>Independent</p>  <p>Living</p>  <p>Skills</p>	<p>Our ILS sessions take place in The Croft each week.</p> <p>With support, students will use instruction sheets to help them prepare simple meals which they will sit together to eat.</p> <p>We will also be practicing household chores (such as hoovering, sweeping, dusting and washing pots) and developing independence around personal routines.</p>

 <p>Options</p>	<p>In Opportunities this term we will be preparing for Makaton Day and the Upper School Production. This will provide many opportunities to carry out fun filled activities, including art, drama and karaoke.</p>
 <p>sport</p>	<p>It is Sports Day this half term so we will be practising for that in our PE lessons. We will also be focusing on exercise and will be having a go at basic circuit training.</p>
 <p>English</p>	<p>This half term we will be looking at the story of Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat, as this is what our students have chosen to perform in the upper school show. We will read the story, sing some of the songs and write captions to go with pictures from the story. We will also be using English skills to make pages for our ROAs using photos from past lessons, and to read and follow recipes and instructions in ILS.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Money: we will be having a weekly 'Upper 1 Café' where students will practise using a menu and using real money. Measurement: we will be weighing, measuring and counting out ingredients during cooking sessions in The Croft. Number: we will be using our number skills in real situations in The Croft, for instance to work out how much food to cook and how many places to set at the table.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p>This term the students will be participating in a number of exciting experiments including testing homemade parachutes, making lemonade and setting off a volcanic eruption!</p>
