


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


Curriculum



Coverage

In the Autumn terms, U2 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>Functional</p>  <p>English</p>	<p>Our topic is 'Me, myself and I'. We will make a booklet or presentation about our family, the things we like and dislike, our hobbies and things we would love to try. We will work on this each week and present it back to the class at the end of term.</p> <p>Reading, writing and speaking/listening skills will be worked on across the week in all lessons. We will work on life skills such as writing a shopping list, reading a list and buying the items in a shop.</p>
 <p>Functional</p>  <p>Maths</p>	<p>We are going to embed math's through all lessons across the week working on a range of practical life skills. We will bake looking at measure, shape & time. We will have a math's café where students will take it in turns to be the shop keeper. They will have to pay for snack and work out change. We will go to the shops near school and use money in real life situations.</p>
 <p>Functional</p>  <p>Computing</p>	<p>Students work as independently as possible to use a range of software. Each week we make a list of jobs on the board and they work their way through them, for example a list of activities for choose time, new symbols, a sign for the door etc. They practice skills when using a laptop and when photocopying and printing their own work.</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>This years OCR unit is 'Emotional Wellbeing'. We will look at happy and sad experiences and what makes us feel this way. We will explore how we can help different friends and how that makes them and ourselves feel. We will also explore bullying, what this is, the consequences of it and how we can deal with it.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p>In science we will be looking at inheritance and evolution. We will learn about cells and study onion cells under a microscope. We will look at baby photos of ourselves and talk about how we have changed. We will look at how we are similar to our families and friends and make a family tree. We will learn about cave people and see how we have evolved.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>We will be looking at what community facilities are available to us. They will select somewhere that they would like to go to explore. We will use a community facility over a period of time, for example the same supermarket so that students get more confident using it and may be able to find things independently.</p>

 <p>Employability</p>	<p>We will look at the rights respecting schools charter and make our own charter for class with rights we think are important. We will look at rights in the workplace and what skills students need to develop their aspirations. We will also make class rules that we will all try our best to stick to.</p> <p>After half term we will begin to make things for the upper Christmas fair. We will have a stall and sell our items to make money for our department.</p>
 <p>Sport</p>	<p>In sport we will be focussing on fitness. We will be using the outdoor gym and do a variety of exercise in class such as aerobics, yoga and dance. We will also do fitness as part of our community lessons. We will go for walks in parks and use a range of playground equipment.</p> <p>We will have weekly swimming lessons on a Friday afternoon.</p>
 <p>Independent Life Skills</p>	<p>The OCR unit for ILS is 'Healthy Living'. We will explore all factors that contribute to a healthy lifestyle and take part in them. We will explore how we can make treats healthier such as making pizzas made on wholemeal tortilla wraps.</p>
