





Curriculum



Coverage

In the Spring Term, Upper 3 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p><b>English</b></p>	<p><u>Media-Films</u></p> <p>In English this term Upper 3 will be focusing on reading, writing, drama and speaking and listening in class through activities relating to our animals topic. We will study the 'Jungle Book' by Rudyard Kipling, examining the relationships in the story between the different animal and human characters.</p>
 <p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p><u>Money, time and number problem solving</u></p> <p>In Maths there will be a focus on practical activities relating to identifying money, measuring ingredients and being aware of the passage of time. In the community students will have the opportunity to use and develop the skills they have learnt in class to recognise and purchase items in shops.</p>
 <p><b>PSD</b></p>	<p>'<u>All About Me</u>' is the title of our PSD topic this term, focussing on following familiar routines at school and home, this will entail looking at personal care routines, routines in lessons and when in the community.</p>
 <p>Life</p>  <p>skills</p>	<p><u>Planning and Preparing Simple Meals</u></p> <p>Students will be using the Croft, class room and food tech room to plan prepare and make a variety of different drinks and snacks, ensuring they are working safely by following basic rules.</p>

 <p>Vocational</p>	<p><u>Personal information.</u>  Students will be 'hands on' in our Enterprise Champions competition. We will plan, create and sell items for our Easter Fayre at the end of the current term. Each class in upper school receives a budget of £20 to 'grow,' the class which grows the most money from their £20 will receive the Champions Trophy.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>All students will have the opportunity to visit the local community on a regular basis throughout the week; this will include a variety of different amenities such as cafes, shops and parks. This should ensure each student is offered a variety of different learning experiences outside the classroom.</p>
