





Curriculum



Coverage

In the Autumn 2, Upper 5 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>English</p>	<p>Films and TV programmes Students will be working on their reading and listening skills by exploring a sensory version of the film Harry Potter. We will be exploring a variety of resources from the film and mark making in relevant resources linked to the film or developing our writing skills linking them to the film.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Measurement Students will be exploring a variety of different ways of measuring items and ingredients. For example measuring the distance of cars traveled down a ramp, measuring ingredients to make biscuits, making these thick and thin. Exploring Russian dolls and making our own with boxes.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>Data Handling Students will be looking at data and using this to make pictograms and charts. We will also be accessing a variety of different equipment including the sensory room, laptops, I-pads and white boards.</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>This term we will be looking at our daily routines and what these are and how we respond to them. We will also be experiencing sensory exploration and building friendships with Tac Pac sessions.</p>
 <p>Life skills</p>	<p>This term we will be experiencing a variety of different shopping facilities and locating the items within the shop. Some students will be participating in planning and preparing simple meals within our independent living unit (The Croft)</p>

 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>This term we will be working on our team building skills, by taking part in practical arts and craft sessions to produce items to sell at the Upper school Christmas Fair. Working together and communication with one another.</p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>Students will continue to develop their understanding of the community they belong to and the facilities available to them.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p>Changing Materials This term we will be focusing on how different materials change. We will be exploring a variety of different sessions for example what happens to solids when added to water, what bends / don't bend, stretchy/ none stretchy.</p>
 <p>Options</p>	<p>This term we will be experiencing music sessions with Mrs Pillar.</p>
 <p>P.E/Physio</p>	<p>Athletics Pupils will either work on the physiotherapy programs and parachute games and/or they will be orienteering around school and the local area.</p>
