











Curriculum



Coverage

In the Spring 4, Upper 5 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p>English</p>	<p>Animals Continuing from last term, students will be working on their listening and reading skills by exploring a sensory version of the story Jungle book. We will be exploring a variety of resources relating to the book and mark making in relevant resources linked to aspects of the text or developing our writing skills.</p>
 <p>Maths</p>	<p>Position & Direction We will be exploring direction in a variety of different ways, by moving ourselves in different directions, dancing in different directions and my making different types of savory snacks rolling these forwards and backwards. Whilst baking we will be working on our practical measuring skills as well as problem solving.</p>
 <p>Computing</p>	<p>This term we will be using a variety of different ICT equipment to make a book about the different equipment we use. The book will also show our favourite equipment.</p>
 <p>PSD</p>	<p>This term we will be looking at our daily routines and what these are and how we respond to them. We will also be experiencing sensory exploration and building friendships with Sherbourne sessions.</p>
 <p>Life skills</p>	<p>This term we will be experiencing a variety of different shopping facilities and locating the items within the shop. Some students will be participating in planning and preparing simple meals within our independent living unit (The Croft)</p>

 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>This term we will be competing with the other upper school classes to win the 'Enterprise Champions' trophy by working together and communication with one another.
