










Curriculum



Coverage

In the Summer 6, Upper 5 will be working on the following topics and themes for sessions.

 <p><b>English</b></p>	<p><b>Me, myself and I</b>  Students will be working on their reading skills by exploring <i>Gangta Granny</i> by David Walliams. We will be exploring a variety of resources from the book and mark making in relevant resources linked to the book or writing skills will be linked to the book.</p>
 <p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p><b>Time and Money</b>  Students will be recapping their knowledge of shape, position and direction. We will be following directions and positioning objects and ourselves, in, out, under, forwards and backwards. Our exploration of shape will be making different and sorting shapes of everyday items.</p>
 <p><b>Computing</b></p>	<p><b>Coding and controlling devices</b>  Students will be exploring and making simple algorithms in the shape of dance and music pattern. We will also be accessing a variety of different equipment including the sensory room, laptops, I-pads and white boards.</p>
 <p><b>PSD</b></p>	<p>During this term we will be talking about how to keep external body parts clean and also indicate and name private body parts as shown on anatomical dolls. Students will also show understanding of personal relationships.  <b>Taught by: Dianne Edinboro</b></p>
 <p><b>Life</b>      <b>skills</b></p>	<p>This term we will prepare a variety of drinks and snacks focusing on the basic safety rules surrounding their preparation. Students will practice independent living skills such as following simple instructions, measuring out liquids and weighing ingredients.</p>

 <p>Vocational</p>	<p>We will continue doing simple jobs within the school community and also visit the café and the Charity shop to see jobs the people do there. There will be visits from Pets as Therapy.</p> <p><b>Taught by Dianne Edinboro</b></p>
 <p>Community</p>	<p>Students will continue to develop their understanding of the community they belong to and the facilities available to them.</p>
 <p>Science</p>	<p><b>Humans and Organisms</b></p> <p>This term we will be focusing on materials and their properties. We will be encounter changes that occur when solids are heated and then cooled. We will also be mixing materials and exploring if these are reversible or irreversible.</p>
 <p>Options</p>	<p>This term we will be undertaking preparations for the summer show.</p>
