


## Year 7 Catch Up Grant Report 16/17

The Year 7 catch up grant is given to any Year 7 students who have not achieved their level 4 in reading or maths.

There were a total of 12 Year 7 students within Key Stage 3 who were eligible for the grant and each received £500.

Consideration was given to the allocation of the grant and through discussions with the class teachers and Assistant Head for Middle School the decision was taken that the following was actioned –

- A TA was appointed on a temporary basis of 2 days from October '16 to July '17.
- The appointed TA worked with students either on a 1:1 basis or in small groups out of the classroom.
- Time for PPA was built into the appointed TA's hours.
