

Year 7 Catch Up Grant Report


The Year 7 catch up grant is given to any Year 7 students who have not achieved their level 4 in reading or maths.

It was decided that the current Year 8 students (who school received the grant money for in this financial year) would receive the grant money support at the beginning of the academic year and the current year 7 students would receive the grant money support from March to July '16.

There were a total of 9 Year 8 students within Key Stage 3 who were eligible for the grant and each received £500.

Consideration was given to the allocation of the grant and through discussions with the class teachers and Assistant Head for Middle School the decision was taken that the following was actioned –

- A TA was appointed on a 23 hours a week temporary basis from October '15 to January '16
- The appointed TA worked within the classes to enable one of the class based TAs to work with students on a 1:1
