

## Year 7 Catch Up Grant Report

The Year 7 catch up grant is given to any Year 7 students who have not achieved their level 4 in reading or maths.

There were a total of 10 Year 7 students within Key Stage 3 who were eligible for the grant and each received £500.

Consideration was given to the allocation of the grant and through discussions with the class teachers and Assistant Head for Middle School the decision was taken that the following was actioned –

- A TA was appointed on a 23 hours a week temporary basis from March '16 to July '16.
- The appointed TA worked 1:1 with students out of the classroom.
- Time for PPA was built into the appointed TAs hours.

The appointed TA was absent for the last month of the grant. Supply cover was in place but it was not consistent and the way the interventions ran changed. Class based TAs worked with the students within class.
